The remaining chapters demonstrate that in spite of this topos, Josephus, Luke, and other religious apologists did tell stories of rich women's associations with their communities for positive rhetorical effect. In so doing, the book challenges the widespread assumption that women's association with foreign religious cults was always derided, questions scholarly arguments about public and private roles in antiquity, and invites reflection on issues of

mission and conversion within the larger framework of Greco-Roman benefaction.
