Cold-blooded criminal record Grim Sleeper killed 180 people over 22 years

2019-07-11 Cold-blooded criminal record "Grim Sleeper" killed 180 people over 22 years There are multiple serial killers in the Los Angeles area Lonnie Franklin was the most notorious 22 years (1985 to 2007) Killed at least ten people and raped 180 women Franklin targeted drug addicts and prostitutes in south Los Angeles Nine of the dead were shot, and the 15-year-old princess was strangled And dumped in a crosswalk in south Los Angeles or in a garbage dump Autopsy results showed Most of the dead had traces of cocaine in their bodies They were sexually assaulted before they died Most of the dead women were found naked or half-naked The women's deaths received little media attention The victim's family blamed the LAPD Indifference to the death of poor blacks Franklin started in 1985 After committing a series of "personal" rapes and murders There was a long period of impunity after 1988 In 2002, he committed another crime because the police "pulled the wrong person" So we're called a Grim Sleeper. In 1985, the body of a 29-year-old black woman It was found next to a garbage dump on West Gage street in south Los Angeles The victim was a prostitute who died after being raped and shot in the chest Wrapped in an old blanket and dumped on the side of the road In 1986, an almost identical crime scene appeared on a street in south Los Angeles The victim showed signs of rape and two gunshot wounds to the chest The bodies were wrapped in blankets and dumped on the roadside The victim was a black woman, 35 years old, a prostitute On January 10, 1987, the police department received an anonymous call: "At 1300 central Alameda 6th

street I saw bodies being carried in petrol barrels The body was thrown from the car to the side of the road like garbage The car the man was driving was a 1976 blue and white van But the driver's face was not clear All I could tell him was: 1PZP746." Police arrived to find the body of Barbara Vail, 23 Shot in the chest, wrapped tape, was first raped after killing A church gate about four kilometers from the body The police found the car that the informant said. (after Franklin's arrest According to the voice print, the call was made by him I believe I want to know the speed of police response and the way of handling the case. The following year saw four more killings in nearby communities Franklin stopped the crime after 1988 Because Washington (30) had a narrow escape The body of 18-year-old Alice in October 1988 Less than a month after the trash was found in the park Franklin hooks up with Washington at a big party Tricked her into getting into the car and drove to the body dump hot spot Vermont square park in Los Angeles Franklin stuns her with his hand and rapes her Shot her twice at point-blank range and threw her out of the car to die A young couple who had been shooting a cannonball nearby heard the shots coming to check Washington was found dying in a pool of blood They called the police and saved her life Washington gave the police a vague description: Black males, ages 30 to 40 She has short hair and is about 1.8 metres tall This clue was not particularly useful at the time Franklin after the attempted murder Stop crime, enter long dormant period (police believe he stopped using "personal" techniques There is no "dormancy" in other ways. Franklin's m.o. was crude Hair and body fluids were left on many of the victims With the same gun, there were fingerprints and tie marks In 2002, A street in south Los Angeles has the same crime scene as it did more than a decade ago The "satyr devil" committed the crime again 13 years later The body of the princess (14 years old) in March 2002 Was found wrapped in some messy garbage bags Dumped like garbage in an alley She died of asphyxiation and was raped before she died Forensic officers extracted the killer's DNA from her vagina It was found in the database to be consistent with seven of the samples The first was in 1985 The sample was transferred to the Los Angeles police department's cold case investigation center After secondary detection and comparison The head of the cold case investigation announced the murder It's the same man who killed street prostitutes more than a decade ago In the serial murders of prostitutes in the 1980s Police collected vaginal extracts, but were unable to keep up with the technology Only a few were tested, and there was no systematic comparison After a serial killer was identified, federal agents and the LAPD Named the serial killer "maleficent." Form a task force called task force 800 Reinvestigate the murder fourteen years ago They offered a \$50,000 reward on "America's most wanted. Hope someone can give us a clue Various signs have also been erected along the highway Warning everyone that the serial killer is still at large Franklin didn't stop until the police were investigating He killed several people over the next few years, and police found the bodies of two of them Not only does he have a DNA match, he goes back to the way he did it more than a decade ago Shoot the victim at close range in the chest with a pistol Police forensics experts confirmed that the gun was one he had used before Over the past 25 years, the police have been unable to find out the true identity of the "sleeper evil" several times to catch the wrong person In 2006, 21 years after the first death The police arrested the suspect for the first time A sixty-five year old white man Roger Hausmann Roger Hausmann kidnapped a black prostitute Lock her up in her basement and rape and beat her He bragged triumphantly about the black woman he had captured I killed all those women I would kill them like stepping on an ant Roger Hausmann caught, Franklin did not take the opportunity to escape Instead, "brand word" In 2007, A homeless man rummaging through trash cans at 9500 south Los Angeles The body of a 25-year-old woman was found wrapped in plastic bags She was shot in the chest, raped and shot DNA in the body, muzzle distance Be wrapped by rubbish bag cast cadge way, it is "demon of evil of deep sleep" mark A month later, the LAPD said at a news conference: Roger Hausmann's DNA sample and "sleepy evil" does not match He's not the killer. oppose it The method requires investigators to take DNA evidence from crime scenes and state databases from 1.3 million felons DNA samples were collected and compared Search for approximate but not exact matches This method has been used for a longer time in the UK It was used as a suspect in a murder case back in 2004 In 2010, A new DNA comparison technique has been introduced in the us justice system The technique compares genes across several families A partial match was found in the database The teenager, Christopher, was charged with a felony gun charge in 2009 His DNA was not available from the DNA database until April 2010 Christopher's DNA and samples from "sleeper. Highly genetically compatible, he may be a brother or a father and son In terms of age, father and son are the most likely DNA searches yielded evidence combined with the date of the murder The police cast their eyes on Christopher's father The technology is very new Franklin's DNA cannot be coerced into court The police sent someone to watch the family, hoping to find more evidence Franklin's little grandson's birthday on July 5, 2010 The police received a tip The family booked a birthday Party at a pizzeria Franklin is sure to be there A plainclothes policeman disguised as a waiter got in As he cleared the table, he carefully removed franklin's cup, knife and fork A slice of leftover pizza, a small piece of chocolate cake Put it on a separate tray to take away In the back of a restaurant Police forensics officers sealed them up with evidence bags Bring it back to the bashensky lab Lab investigators found DNA on leftover pizza Notify lapd of franklin's DNA And 11 serial rape and murder scene found DNA all match Police searched the garage of franklin's south Los Angeles home Police recovered the gun used in the attack, which was not far from the scene where the body was dumped After franklin was caught, police removed him from his home Hundreds of hours of video and thousands of photographs of women Some of the women posed provocatively naked, while others were apparently drugged Some of them were apparently photographed posthumously as mementos Franklin's record keeping is also chilling Some photos are too bloody No photos of all the dead known to police have been taken Video is too bloody and not made public One hundred and eighty pictures of women "suspected victims" Presumably as a memento of franklin's sexual assault victims. Most of the photos are of African American women Very few are latino or white women, and none are Asian Franklin was formally arrested on July 7, 2010 The police charged him with ten counts of first-degree murder One count of attempted murder, one count of unlawful possession of a deadly weapon Franklin retired as a garbage collector in Los Angeles He drives a recycling truck every day and is the main tool to suppress evidence He often strangled or shot his victims on the mountainside or at night Most of the victims were of African origin, ranging in age from 14 to 35 After killing, throw their naked bodies on the roadside or in garbage cans A police investigation found that franklin had a history of sexual abuse He has always had low self-esteem in the face of the opposite sex, just like these victims He also belongs to the bottom of American society and has always lacked self-confidence That would explain his repeated attempts at murder In order to get great satisfaction from trampling on female victims Shoot him in the chest to show off the power he craves Franklin, 57, on July 8, 2010 Accused of killing seven women between August 1985 and September 1988 After thirteen years of silence Three people were killed between March 2002 and January 2007 Prosecutors say franklin is involved in five other murders Detectives believe he killed at least 25 women The prosecution could only charge him with ten counts of murder because of the difficulty of providing evidence Franklin, who is black, was born in Los Angeles in 1952 Married with two children, works as a city cleaner for Los Angeles Worked as a parking attendant for the city police department He was arrested only in July 2010. Mr Franklin denies any involvement Not a word was said during the long trial Franklin and his wife She lives at the corner of an alley on 81st street in south Los Angeles They lived in the mint green house for thirty-two years Everyone around him said franklin was a good man with a good heart Including his Brazilian wife of more than 30 years Two sons and five grandchildren Franklin's first crime was in 1985 He was thirty-two years old He doesn't have any prior criminal record Just petty theft, trespassing 1985 street prostitute Debra Jackson (29) She was found naked next to a trash can in a park There were strangulation marks on his neck and multiple stab wounds on his body The cause of death was two gunshot wounds to the chest The murderer put his gun to her body and fired She had a large gunpowder burn on her skin A year later, franklin did something similar Killed Henrietta (34), and dumped her body not far away Two days later, franklin killed a man the same way He was the only man franklin killed A black pimp named Thomas Steele The police arrested four suspects before and after Three

were sent to prison on charges other than murder More than a year later Five prostitutes were found dead, all from gunshot wounds The number of women missing during this period was about 30 or 40 December 16, 2010 Police say they found it at franklin's home One hundred and fifty of the women were photographed, asking the public for help identifying them But 35 women are still missing The case was heard for three months on May 5, 2016 Franklin was convicted by a jury of having been at large for more than two decades The "sleeper killer" who killed several women in a row Surviving victim woman Washington As a witness nearly three decades later She could not believe that franklin was so cold and unrepentant Calling him a "demon" and a "homicidal maniac" Prosecutors handed over a semi-automatic pistol recovered from franklin's home Two criminal experts testified at the trial The gun was the one that killed one of the victims The defense argued that the police did not have court permission to take the defendant's DNA Invasion of privacy without informing the defendant The evidence obtained in this way does not conform to the standard and is invalid The lawyers argue that another mystery man killed the women May the jury spare franklin's life The prosecution argued that the invasion of privacy was limited to what the defendant had Restaurants are owned by restaurateurs, and for others are public Spaces The evidence the police collected was, by definition, "rubbish" Is automatically waived by default It is only natural that the police should dig out rubbish The court ruled that the DNA samples were valid evidence Show it to the jury The prosecutor in charge of the case, John silverman, stressed Franklin had no chance of enlightenment: "He was a psychopathic, sadistic serial killer Having fun hurting and killing women. " Silverman said franklin was malicious His crime was carefully planned and cruel He delighted in killing and torturing, and asked the jury to sentence him to death The jury of seven women and five men deliberated for about eight hours before reaching a consensus Franklin was found guilty of 10 counts of murder and one count of attempted murder Recommended that the judge sentence franklin to death Los Angeles superior court presiding judge John f. Kennedy The names of ten victims and each case were read out He would tell franklin that you would be sentenced to death In sentencing May 10, judge Kennedy said: "This sentence is not for revenge, but for justice Nothing can make up for what you've done One thing is clear, you have a deep hatred of women a long time ago I've worked in the criminal justice system for many years Never have I seen such a terrible crime committed. " California has filed an automatic appeal against its death sentence Prison officials will be sentenced to death by lethal injection Franklin may have spent the rest of his life in SAN quentin California faces a number of lawsuits over "lethal injection" California has not carried out a death penalty since 2006 Franklin was the 744 th inmate on death row An anonymous prison boss while franklin was still behind bars Let go of saying, "he should always live in fear." There's no chance franklin will make it out of prison alive
