Richard Koper Barbara Nichols (1928-1976), the “dame with the shapely frame,” changed her reddish-brown hair to platinum blonde, drew whistles as a semi-nude post-World War Two pin-up model, and was named Miss Long Island. Broadway beckoned and she drew attention in the Pal Joey musical. When Hollywood called, she filled a dubious niche in small, wisecracking roles, wringing both comedy and tragedy from cheesy, dim-witted stereotypical strippers, gold-diggers, barflies, gun molls, and floozies. Barbara scored great reviews in films, such as Pal Joey (1957), Sweet Smell of Success (1957) and The Pajama Game (1957).
